

FALL TAG



MATERIALS:

- 1 – 1 ½” x 2 ½” Woodsies® Tag by Forster®
- 1 – ¾” x 1 ½” Woodsies® Rectangle by Forster®
- 1 – 1 ½” x 2 ½” Green Cardstock
- 1 – ¾” x 2 ¼” Copper Colored Scrapbooking Mesh
- 1 – 15” length - Copper Colored Fun Fibers
by EK Success Adornments™
- Oak Gel Stain by DecoArt™
- Size 6 Flat Stain Paintbrush by Loew-Cornell®
- Copper Colored Leaf Charm
- 1/2” Round Alphabet Stickers by K & Company®
- Craft Stick Glue by Scotch®

Miscellaneous Items: scissors; ruler; pencil, hole-punch.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **“FALL” TAG.** Apply Oak Stain to Wood Rectangle with Paintbrush. Let dry. Remove “FALL” Stickers from backing and apply to Wood Rectangle as shown in photo.

2. **ASSEMBLY.** Place Wood Tag onto back of Green Cardstock and trace around Wood Tag with Pencil. Cut on drawn lines. Using Craft Stick Glue, attach Cardstock to Wood Tag. With Hole-Punch, punch a hole through the Cardstock at top of Tag. Glue Scrapbooking Mesh onto Tag. Attach leaf charm with Craft Stick Glue, pressing firmly to attach Charm and Mesh to Tag. Attach Wood Rectangle with Craft Stick Glue on top of Mesh.

3. **FINISHING.** Cut Fiber to form one 12” length and one 3” length. Fold 12” length in half and thread folded fiber end through hole in Tag from front to back. Place cut ends of Fiber through folded end and pull until folded end is snug against the Tag. Thread one end of 3” Fiber through folded end and pull until ends are even. Trim Fiber ends as desired.
